

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

KONSTANTINOS STENGOS, son of Andreas

CHAIRMAN OF THE GROUP OF COMPANIES OF TECHNIKI OLYMPIAKI

Konstantinos Stengos, Civil Engineer, is the founder and Chairman of the Group of Companies of TECHNIKI OLYMPIAKI. In 1955 he was admitted to the School of Civil Engineering of the National Technical University of Athens. In 1965 he founded in Patras the construction company PELOPS Ltd., which in 1967 obtained the then highest Class E contractor's licence. In 1980 the company was renamed TECHNIKI OLYMPIAKI S.A. and, until 2000, when it was converted into a holding company, it held a contractor's licence of the then highest Class H.

In 1973 he founded the technical company MOCHLOS S.A., which, until its merger into TECHNIKI OLYMPIAKI S.A., held the highest Class 7 contractor's licence. TECHNIKI OLYMPIAKI S.A. and MOCHLOS S.A. were listed on the Main Market of the Athens Stock Exchange in 1994, where TECHNIKI OLYMPIAKI S.A. remains listed to this day. In 1976 he also founded the technical company TOXOTIS ATE, which today is engaged in the execution of private projects.

At the end of 1996, the TECHNIKI OLYMPIAKI Group, through its subsidiaries, expanded its activity abroad (United Kingdom, Germany) and, from 1998 onwards, developed other business activities, such as wind energy and the construction and operation of self-financed tourist marinas, while at the same time establishing a presence in the Balkan market (Romania) for the construction of various technical projects.

In 1999, through the acquisition of 80% of the U.S. company NEWMARK HOMES Inc., listed on NASDAQ in New York, the Group expanded its activities in the United States in the field of urban real estate (homebuilding). In 2000, it acquired 100% of the U.S. company ENGLEHOMES Inc. (also previously listed on NASDAQ), thus further expanding its penetration into the U.S. homebuilding market. In 2004, trading of the common share of its subsidiary TECHNICAL OLYMPIC USA (TOUSA) was transferred from the NASDAQ Stock Market to the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE).

In 1999, the Group acquired the PORTO CARRAS Complex and entered the field of hotel, tourism, agricultural and industrial operations, until the sale of the Complex in April 2020.

In most of the above companies, Mr. Konstantinos Stengos served as Chairman of the Board of Directors and, in some cases, also as Chief Executive Officer.

At present, the Group operates in the sectors of Shipping, Real Estate Management (Real Estate Investment and/or Development), Tourism, mainly in relation to marina management, Energy, Real Estate Advisory and Brokerage Services, and Construction.
